# *For Land's Sake!*

## *A Conservation Strategy for Edisto*



For twenty-one years, EIOLT has concentrated on protecting the scenic views and grand live oaks lining the National Scenic Byway 174 Corridor, along with working farms and fragile marsh land on our beautiful sea island. This focus has successfully helped preserve the beauty and rural character of Edisto that residents and visitors love. Now, we are directing greater attention to protect the lifeblood of Edisto Island – our creeks and surrounding saltmarshes.

Edisto's creeks and saltmarshes teem with blue crabs, shrimp, flounder and mullet, all staples of local cuisine. Many island residents rely on these creeks to provide their families with a source of protein. The marshes are nurseries for fish favored by sport and commercial fishermen. Hammock islands are known as "biodiversity hotspots" and are home to plants, birds and insects that prefer these islands to any other habitat. Intact marshland prevents bank erosion and buffers homes and agricultural fields from flooding damage.

Conserving high ground adjacent to creeks and marshes is key to maintaining these healthy, vibrant community resources. EIOLT is reaching out to owners whose properties front Russell, Store and Sand Creeks, as well as those that border Botany Bay Plantation Wildlife Management Area. Our work together with these owners will prevent over development that could have a negative impact on water or wildlife, while allowing land owners to continue enjoying private use of their property. Newly protected properties will link to other protected properties, creating unbroken wildlife habitat corridors along the creeks and around Botany Bay.

## *A Powerful Conservation Tool*

Many landowners who were previously unable to place their land under conservation easements due to financial concerns will now be able to join us in our mission. In December of 2015, Congress made permanent the **Federal Conservation Easement Tax Incentive**, which allows modest-income landowners to receive greater credit for donating a very valuable conservation easement on their property. The incentive raises the deduction the donor can take, extends the carry-forward period for them to take the tax deduction and even allows qualifying farmers to deduct up to 100% of their income! This enhanced federal tax incentive, combined with local support for conservation, will assist us in protecting Edisto's important ecological resources.

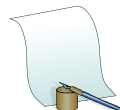

# Back to Nature Events



## Winter Bird Feeding Lecture

In January we hosted a Winter Bird Feeding lecture at the Edisto Beach State Park Interpretive Center. EIOLT board member and Ornithologist Dr. Sid Gauthreaux described how to attract specific bird species to your feeders with different types of seed. A packed house learned the basics of feeding hummingbirds and orioles during the winter.

## Bluebird Nest Box Building

On a beautiful February afternoon at historic Sunny Side Plantation we had a great group come out to build their own bluebird nest boxes with local naturalist Carroll Belser. Carroll also gave a presentation about bluebird behavior and what you can do to attract them to your yard.

## Plant Ecology Walk

Our March outing featured a special guest, Joel Gramling, Associate Professor of Plant Ecology and Curator of The Citadel Herbarium, for a nature walk in the Bailey Island Preserve. Joel shared his wealth of knowledge of plant identification, ecological interactions and how to read the landscape of our maritime forests and wetlands.

## Nature Photography

The April workshop was for those new to nature photography, whether you use a cell phone, point and shoot or digital single lens reflex camera. The focus was on non-technical practical tips for getting good outdoor shots. Bill Johnston, a Certified Master Naturalist who works on the island as a natural resources technician for SCDNR at Botany Bay, led the workshop.

## Heirs' Property Workshop

Also in April, the land trust collaborated with the Center for Heirs' Property Preservation to offer a free seminar for Edisto and surrounding area residents who live on heirs' property and want to learn about obtaining clear title to their land. In addition, information was provided about a new sustainable forestry program for African Americans.

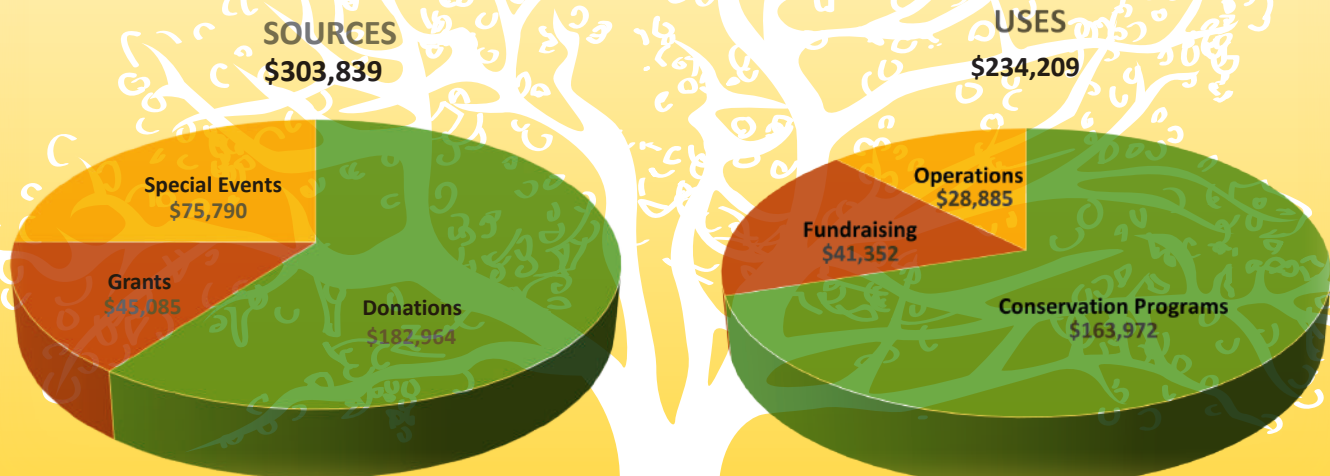
# Share Our Story

## Young Naturalist Club Field Notes

The members of our Young Naturalist Club visited Botany Bay Plantation for their January class. Despite a cold, windy day, we made plaster casts of deer tracks and learned all about the habits of white tailed deer. Bess Kellett, volunteer coordinator for Botany Bay, graciously showed everyone her collection of skulls, bones, feathers and other finds. We even met a corn snake!

In February, the Club learned about creek creatures at the Edisto Beach State Park Interpretive Center. Ranger Ashby took us out to the dock to do a plankton tow. It was so windy we almost blew away! We brought our catch back to the classroom and studied the plankton under microscopes. Interpreter Rosa taught us about several species of local crabs. We got to shake hands with a horseshoe crab and to hold hermit crabs!

Signs of spring were everywhere when we returned to Botany Bay in March. Bluebirds and chickadees had built nests in boxes. No eggs yet, though. We saw woodpeckers pecking for insects and egrets hunting for fish. Everything was covered in pollen, even spider webs, and many trees had brand new leaves.
