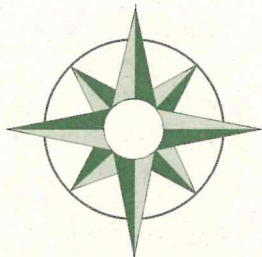

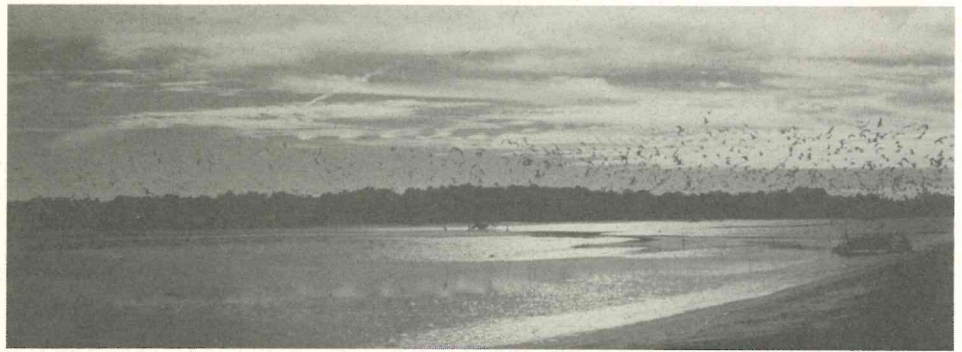

## EIOLT Focuses On Community Litter Patrol Program

This year, the Edisto Island Open Land Trust focused on the need for a community cleanup project by stepping forward to undertake the responsibility of keeping Edisto Island clean by implementing a new litter control program along Highway 174.

The land trust contracted to pick up trash along Edisto's Scenic Highway and to date, the community has been overwhelmingly supportive of the trust's efforts by donating funds toward the ongoing Litter Patrol program.

"We're tickled to death with it," says Edisto Island Open Land Trust President Jenkins Mikell. "We've been paying to get litter picked up every Saturday and so far it's working."

By picking up trash from the Dawho Bridge to Edisto Beach along Highway 174, the land trust is striving to promote community pride in the beauty that is Edisto Island. To date, the Litter Patrol has collected more than four hundred bags of litter, which amounts to about 8,200 pounds of trash.

The Litter Patrol program comes in the wake of the well-known Adopt-A-Highway program, which involved area businesses and civic clubs who sponsored a one day clean up of Edisto Island each year.

But the land trust recognized that a more permanent solution was needed to keep Edisto litter-free, so members of the Litter Patrol dedicate every Saturday to ridding Highway 174 of debris.

Like most community-based programs, the Edisto Island Litter Patrol



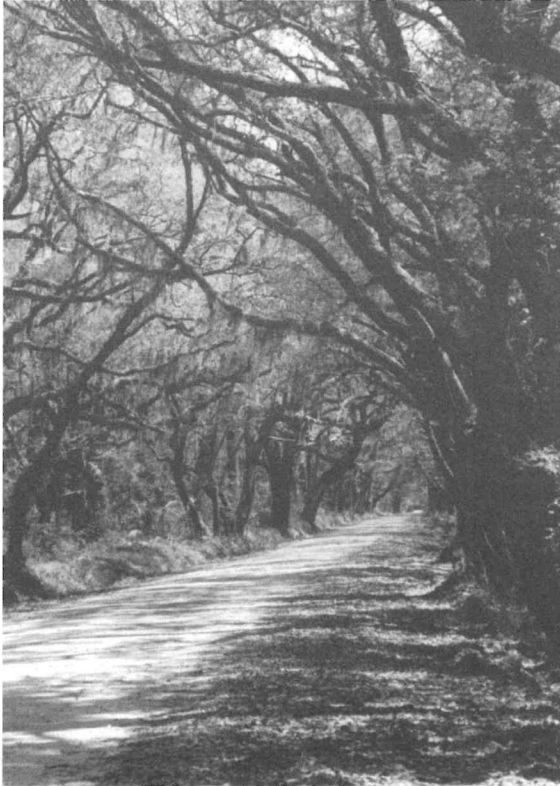
requires local funding to be successful. Without the financial support of the entire community, the program will fail since the Litter Patrol costs about \$20,000 a year to pay for laborers.

The Edisto Island Open Land Trust currently has a fundraising campaign in progress to help pay for the program, which is vital to the Edisto community since litter is an ongoing problem along Highway 174, where commercial vehicles and open bed pickup trucks are the greatest contributors to debris.

In fact, according to Keep America Beautiful of South Carolina, the number-one source of roadside litter in South Carolina is uncovered vehicles. The state litter law requires that a vehicle must be loaded so as not to spill or it must be covered.

The Litter Patrol program is another positive way the Edisto Island Open Land Trust is preserving and protecting the scenic views and vistas of Edisto Island. \*

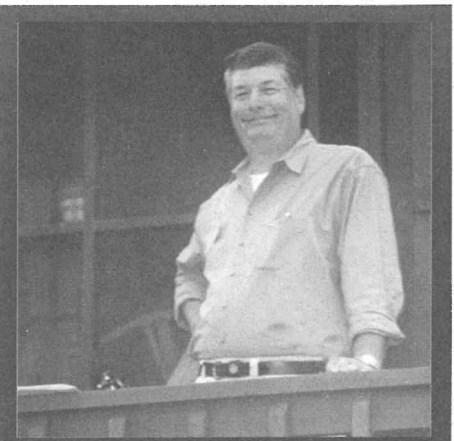
*Limited development* allows a portion of a piece of property to be

The landowner enters into a perpetual legal agreement with the land trust that permanently restricts harmful uses and development of the property. The land remains in private ownership and use, as designed by the property owner in conjunction with the land trust.

A conservation easement is one of the best ways that property owners can preserve their land, benefit from tax advantages and enjoy the open vistas of Edisto Island without risking development of the land in order to pay for often substantial property taxes.
