TWO NEW PROPERTIES PROTECTED BY EIOLT

Easement on Peters Point Road Island



Monsignor James A. Carter, P.A., Pastor at Mt. Pleasant's Christ our King Church, used to visit Edisto frequently when his aunt, Dr. Patricia Carter would reside at her island home just off Peters Point Road. Dr. Carter was member and supporter of the Edisto Island Open Land Trust, and when she died in 2004, she left the property to her nephew. Jim Carter loves spending quiet days here surrounded by the beauty of Shell House Creek and a vast panorama of uninterrupted marsh. To preserve these scenic views, he recently donated conservation easement on this 4.5 acre property to the EIOLT. This conservation easement was written to fulfill the owner's wishes that there be no additional structures or docks on this land, and the EIOLT is delighted to be entrusted with the stewardship of this property with its magnificent views. Thanks to conservation-minded property owners like Jim Carter, we are saving Edisto's natural landscape, one scenic property at a time.

Easement on Scenic Toogoodoo Creek Property



The Edisto Island Open Land Trust was delighted to accept this easement from a conservation-committed young married couple, Tom Hutto and Barbara Neale. They are a typical two-career couple who have too little time to spend at

home on a beautiful tract overlooking Toogoodoo Creek, just across the Dawhoo River from Edisto. What makes Barbara and Tom different is their love of the land and the surrounding area. Over a year ago they created a partnership with friends to purchase a large wooded area adjacent to their homes, because they were worried that otherwise, it would be densely developed in a manner out of character with the area. Since then the property has been divided among the partners, and Tom and Barbara have donated

Pending Tax Law Changes Could Benefit Landowners

After a year's delay, Congress is once again considering the long-awaited tax law enhancements for landowners who donate conservation easements to land trusts.

Currently Federal tax law allows a donor to utilize the value of his conservation easement by deducting from his federal income tax up to 30% of adjusted gross income each year for the year of the donation and for five years thereafter. Last November, the US Senate passed a tax bill with an expansion of the Federal tax incentives for conservation easement donors, and with reforms designed to prevent abusive appraisals. The Senate bill raised the cap on tax deductions from 30% of the donor's adjusted gross income to 50% - and to 100% for farmers and ranchers who donate easements on their farmland! The bill also provided for extending the carry-forward period for using these tax deductions from 5 to 15 years. The House subsequently passed a companion bill which did not include these increased tax incentives, leaving the ultimate fate of conservation donors to be decided by a Joint House-Senate Conference Committee. This Committee will try to resolve the differences between the House and Senate tax bills

FROM THE DIRECTOR

When you think about the future, do you ever picture what Edisto Island will look like in the year 2020? We know there will be some changes, but will it still be a rural island community? Will it still have plenty of open space, woods, and marsh views filled with songbirds, wading and sea birds and other critters? Will unpolluted creeks and rivers still teem with crabs, shrimp, oysters, and fish? Or will Edisto have succumbed to typical sprawl, like the wall to wall condos, strip malls, commercial establishments and parking lots on James Island, Johns Island, and Mt. Pleasant. We cannot let this happen here . . . and we must not leave it to chance. That's why your Land Trust is launching a project to create a 5-Year Strategic Plan and 10-Year Vision to serve as a guide for preserving the quality of life on Edisto through land preservation.

The EIOLT Strategic Planning Task Force – a distinguished group of volunteers and EIOLT board members – will start work at the end of March and will be in touch with EIOLT members and other community stakeholders to ask for your ideas and your vision of Edisto's future. *Driving down Highway 174, what would you like to see? What areas do you consider a priority for preservation? What role do you want your land trust to fulfill in the Edisto community?* Feedback from interviews or surveys with stakeholders will be compiled and presented to the EIOLT Board, who will convene for an all-day meeting on September 22 to draft the 2006-2010 Strategic Plan.

To accelerate land protection on Edisto we need your input, so if you hear from the EIOLT Strategic Planning Task Force, please take the time to give them your feedback. No one else is going to save our island but us! The future of Edisto is in your hands.

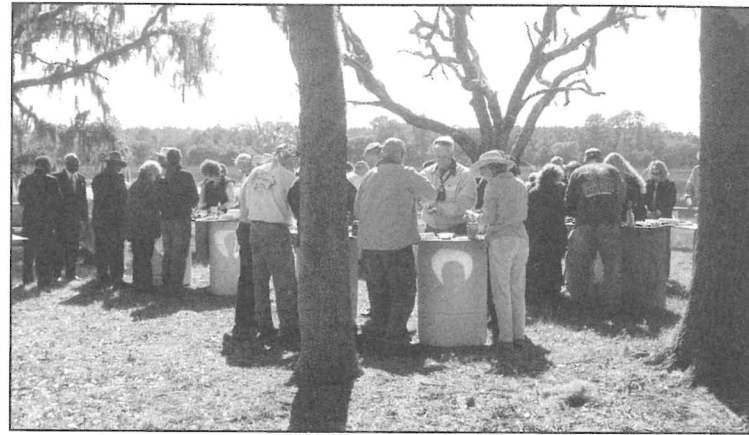
Recent EIOLT Community Events



It's hard to beat an early spring oyster roast with blue skies reflecting in a lazy tidal creek and a balmy breeze keeping the insects at bay. That's what 350 Edisto Island Open Land Trust members and supporters experienced at EIOLT's Annual Meeting & Oyster Roast on Sunday, March 5, where they gathered around tables piled high with the best of Lowcountry fare. They were entertained by gospel music from the New First Baptist Church Men's Choir, followed by demonstrations of bird raptors by the International Birds of Prey Center.

This year the oyster roast took place on Edisto's Sand Creek Farm, hosted by owner and EIOLT Board Member, Lex Crawford. EIOLT President, BoBo Lee thanked Enterprise Bank of SC, our Oyster Roast sponsor for the third year in a row, and recognized the large group from

Enterprise Bank who attended. He also thanked the New First Baptist Church Men's Choir and the International Birds of Prey for donating the entertainment, Jim Kempson, who donated the beverages for the event, and all the individuals who worked to make the day a success. Marian Brailsford recognized recent conservation easement donors – Tom Hutto, Barbara Neale, and James Carter – and wrapped up the business announcements with a request for donations to the Revolving Acquisition Fund. She said, "The purpose of the acquisition fund is to purchase land that otherwise would be developed, re-sell it with restrictions in place, and roll the acquisition fund over time and again to save other endangered land on Edisto."



Members Approve New By-Laws at Annual Meeting

At the March 5 Annual Meeting EIOLT members voted to approve the "First Amended By-Laws of the Edisto Island Open Land Trust, Inc." The vote was 187 "for" and 2 "against," and the new by-laws were certified by Lex Crawford, Secretary of the Board of Trustees, effective March 5, 2006. Changes made to the By-Laws include:

- Number of EIOLT Board members increased from 15 to 21, each serving 3-year terms with consecutive terms allowed.
- Voting – The Board of Directors will have the ability to manage the increasingly complex operation of the organization without the requirement for member voting.
- Supermajority voting – Two-thirds of all EIOLT Board members must vote to approve any motion to: buy/sell land, borrow money, accept easements, change the by-laws, dissolve, or hire/terminate staff.
